## **3 Important Steps**

- Use weatherstripping to seal windows and doors where they meet the frame. Paintable caulk can fill and seal any cracks around the outside of window and door frames. For large holes or cracks use Great Stuff™ For Windows and Doors.
- Check the door sweeps on the bottom of all your exterior doors to make sure they are creating a tight seal. If you have a screen door be sure its hydraulic closer is working properly to prevent excess drafts from entering your home.
